

H.E. "SPEEDY" WILSON DETACHMENT UNIFORM POLICY

- 1. The official uniform of the Marine Corps League is the Marine Corps League cover. The MCL cover is always requested and appropriate to wear. The other piece of attire most worn is the red long sleeve or red polo shirt with the Detachment logo. For most events we have (meetings, socials, booths, etc.), it is requested that the MCL cover and Detachment shirt will be worn. All Detachment members are highly encouraged to obtain at least the MCL cover, and a Detachment shirt. Contact the Quartermaster for assistance.
- 2. The most noticeable uniform of the MCL, is the Casual uniform (also referred to as the Red Blazer). For events of a more formal or ceremonial nature (dinners, Fallen Marine, etc.), the preferred uniform will be the Casual uniform. The Casual uniform may be requested to be worn, so it is encouraged that Detachment members also procure this uniform.
- 3. There is also the Undress Uniform (both long and short sleeve) and the Formal Uniform. Different situations may call upon these uniforms to be worn, such as at conventions or Marine Corps Birthday Ball celebrations.
- 4. All the uniforms have very high exacting standards. These standards have changed and are always subject to change, so please take time to familiarize yourself and adhere to the current regulations regarding each uniform.
- 5. However, under no circumstances, should not having or not being in the requested uniform prohibit a Detachment member from participating in any Detachment event. Your presence and participation at the event are more important than the requested uniform for the event. If there is ever a uniform question in your mind, see the first sentence of paragraph number 1.
